 into the p[er]t[ic]ular at or upon the death day of October next ensuing after the date of abill w[er]e
 we have here in C[our]t to present under the hand & seal of our said Justice bearing date as aforesaid
 he the said Dully did send himself his heirs & assigns to pay the aforesaid Summe of 400^{li} of
 tobacco the p[er]t[ic]ular according to the tenor of the bill but he the said Dully still regarding his bill prom[is]e
 in assumption but fraudulently intending the p[er]t[ic]ular to receive of the Summe aforesaid doth deny & still
 will deny to pay the same although often thereunto required by the p[er]t[ic]ular whereupon the p[er]t[ic]ular
 is damaged & hath damage to the value of 200^{li} of tobacco & thereupon brings this suit

 River unto the said Robert Hall at or upon the death day of October next ensuing
 after the date hereof and for the true performance of these presents I bind me my heirs & assigns

and assignes as witness my hand & seal the 23rd day of July 1623 John Dully

The Premises being considered This Court grants an Attachment on the goods Chattels & Debts
 of John Dully for the value of eight hundred thirty six pounds of tobacco to answer unto Robert
 Hall of Debt in March 6th next

Some of the County of Middlesex Edward Smith late of the County was summoned to answer unto John Rhoads of the County
 County in a plea of Debt &c
 And whereupon the p[er]t[ic]ular of Thomas Poole his Attorney Com[miss]ioner & Justice of the Peace for the County of Middlesex
 the 23rd day of April in the year of our Lord 1621 became indebted unto the p[er]t[ic]ular the full & Just
 Summe of six hundred pounds of good ware of shewell tobacco & cast to be paid the tenth day of
 October next ensuing after the date of abill w[er]e we have here in C[our]t to present under the hand of
 our said Justice bearing date as aforesaid whereupon the said Edward did send himself his heirs
 & assigns to pay the aforesaid Summe of tobacco according to the tenor of the aforesaid bill
 but he the said Edward still regarding his bill but fraudulently intending the p[er]t[ic]ular to receive of the
 Summe aforesaid doth deny & still doth deny to pay the same although often thereunto required
 by the p[er]t[ic]ular whereupon the p[er]t[ic]ular is damaged & hath damage to the value of one hundred
 pounds of tobacco & thereupon brings this suit
