was returned by the sheriff the 14th day of August last past & was attached on the 15th day of June last past...
13th day of November last at the request of the pte the Court ordered that William Elgate Senr & Daniell Hest were
appointed appraisers to appraise the said articles they being first sworn before some one Magistrate of
this County; then weigh them and make true appraisment to the best of their skill & knowledge and give report
thereof to the next County Court to be holden on Tuesday in January And this day to wit the 5th day of
February 1603 the said Wm Elgate & Daniell Hest made return in manner & forme following vizt
Memorandum this day the 15th of December 1603 Whereas by virtue of y^e above mentioned order we have
above mentioned Wm Elgate Senr & Daniell Hest being sworn before us William Breton one of our Justices
Justices of the Peace for this County above said in due time to the above mentioned order have weighed the
Articles w^{ch} weigh one thousand forty six pounds w^{ch} we appraise & value at one pound of tobacco
per pound in confirmation of w^{ch} we the above mentioned have hereunto set our hands and seals the day
and year above written

And upon this day to wit the 5th day of February during the 1603 this Court ordered that the two cheques
attached of me William Jarvile be delivered by the sheriff to Capt John Under or his assignees for the
use of Capt John Under being in part of debt proved due to him from the said William Jarvile

This day to wit the 5th day of February 1603 were published restrictions between Hope Taylor & Margaret
Daniels both of this County no person forbidding the same

This Court adjourned till the Morrow morning eight of y^e next

Godwin the pte & the said John Baker def^r now in consideration of the said Francis Baker def^r he promised to pay
tobacco to pay the said debt faithfully assume and promise to pay to y^e pte the above said two
pair of shoes in March last past notwithstanding of y^e said assumption and promise y^e said Francis Baker
and his heirs intending to deprive the pte hath utterly refused the payment of the said shoes & yet doth
deny the same to the pte great loss & damage to y^e value of two hundred pounds of tobacco & here upon
bringe his sute

James Sangster sworn y^e he engaged to pay him 2 pair of shoes Francis Baker maker
Francis Baker appeares in his owne person hath no plea this Court ordered y^e the said Francis Baker
Sangster two pair of French fall shoes & lost value of two hundred pounds of tobacco
