The Jurors for the R<sup>th</sup> hono<sup>ble</sup> the Lord prop<sup>ty</sup> being sworn upon the holy Evangel  
 at a grand Jury held for the body of this County in November last past did present  
 find that Lawrence Young of this County planter and John Kemp at sundry & divers  
 times have most wickedly Maliciously and invidiously wronged and defrauded their  
 Neighbours in and about the plantation of the said Young by feloniously Stealing  
 Killing and Carrying away his Neighbours hogs and Cattle and clandestinely Absconding  
 their flesh guts and haire in unusual places and whereof severall the inhabitants  
 throabouts being Jealous of the said Lawrence & having sustained great Loss in  
 their Stocks and missing severall of their hogs did by vertue of a warrant search the  
 plantation of the said Young by the Constable upon the 27<sup>th</sup> and 28<sup>th</sup> day of October last  
 past and there did find a forty gallon Cask of porks hid in the woods by a  
 New brush fence under an Old Crow and hogs guts fresh by the back side and in  
 William Collins potato patch was found our hogs guts together with Siver & Deight  
 In another ward the said Youngs house was also found three hogs guts and hogs haire  
 with the Cattle and fatt upon each and also in the afores<sup>d</sup> W<sup>ch</sup> where the guts were found  
 were the horns of a b<sup>e</sup>ast of our yard and a half Old and the horns of another of  
 about seven yard Old together with haire and Callow w<sup>ch</sup> in the whole amounteth  
 to the value of Nynety hundred Nynety and Nynety pound of Tobacco. Whereupon his Lord  
 Attorney Generall said that the said Lawrence Young hath most feloniously defrauded  
 defrauded his Neighbours injured and outraged his Lordships good Laws and against  
 the publick peace therefore Cause indue may be entered ag<sup>t</sup> the said Young and Kemp  
 according to Law in that Case provided by Warrant read viz<sup>t</sup>
