 Open Court acknowl-ge^d thoms-wood to stand indebted to the R^{ty} hono^{ble} the Lord prop^{ty} right
 the said John Kemp in the sume of forty pounde Sterling and Walter Caylor & Henry
 Hayman each in fifteen pounde ster^l. agreed to be Leased on their goods and Chattels Land
 and Commetment for the use of the Lord prop^{ty} afores^d.
 The Condition being such that if the above bound John Kemp shall and will be of the good
 b^e-havi^or towards all his Lordps^s good people as also will make his person all app^r-arances
 every Court during pleasure and that he will pay all officers fees due from him that then
 the above Obligation to be void otherwise to remaine in full force &c.

The Jur^os for the R^{ty} hono^{ble} the Lord prop^{ty} being Sworn upon the holly Evangelist at a
 grand Jury hold for the body of this County the second Tw-eday in November last past 1688
 prosee and find that Lawrence Young upon the Sabbath day of the Month Anno Domⁱ 1688
 in weeding time most Atheistically wickedly and prophane^{ly} did vilify & Blaspheme
 God Almighty and did openly d^e-clare that the holly and sacred Word of God contained in the
 Bible knowⁿ by the Name of the Old and New Testam^{en}t was fals^e and not our word of
 Truth in them w^{ch} said Young was so wicked as to declare and publish w^{ch} said Atheistica^l
 Expression the Devils thoms-wood dare not to Express as d^e-viling the religion of plaus^e
 and made manifest in the said Word whereby he hath d^e-clared hims^e-lf an Enemy to
 God that gave him life and breath our Saviour Jesus Christ and Salvation by him and the
 holly Ghost that inspired the holly w^ord of God to give forth the word wherefore his Lordps^s
 Attourney Generall may be entred ag^t the said Young according to the merit of the said
 offence &c.

Upon which Cause Lawrence Young in his proper person and pleaded not guilty & for his
 Crayall putt hims^e-lf upon the Country.

Whereupon Command was given to the Sheriff of this County to call to Court here Tw-^{ed}
 good & Lawfull men of his Baywick by whomd &c. and who neither &c. to recognize &c.
 b^e-caus^e as w^{ell} &c.

Now here at this day (viz^t) the 12th day of June in the sixth year of his Lordps^s
 Dominion & Anno Domⁱ 1689 caused the said Lawrence Young to the Court and the
 Jur^os of that Jury like wise caused that is to say John Woff William Danson George
 Land John Heath w^{ch} Richardson Hope Caylor Thomas Morris John Joud^e Marsay
 Fountain John Frodrick Walter Calbert and John Barker who being & Cotted Crayd
 and Sworn to say the truth in the premises upon the Oath did say w^ord of the Jury do
 find Lawrence Young guilty

It was therefore Ordered by this Court that the Sheriff of this County take the afores^d
 Lawrence Young into Custody and that on his bare back w^{ch} laid on he give him Ch^{ain}
 Shipes which was ordered as also that the said Lawrence Young give good & suff^{ic}
 Security as w^{ell} for his b^e-havi^or as for his app^r-arances every Court during pleasure
