Whereupon it was Order^d by this Court that Josias Seward and Samuel Colind both of this County do^r examine what Cloaths the said Elizab-th Col-bourne had b^r longing to the Orphans of the said John Root deed and that after Examination thereof so^r had & taken And the same Valued & Appraized as to them shall seem most convenient to make report thereof to the Justices of the Next County Court to be holden the second Tuesday in August next = And it is further Ordered that the said Elizab-th Col-bourne give Suffitout Security as well for her b^r haviour as for her app-arrained every Court during pleasure - Lewis William Col-bourne (wher^r his husband of the afores^d Elizab-th Col-bourne John Bratton & Hora Taylor in Open Court did acknowledge thoms-End to stand justly & true unto the R^t. hon^e the Lord prop^r & Sir William Col-bourne afores^d for his said wife in the sume of Thirtie pounds Sterling John Bratton & Hora Taylor each in fifteen pounds Sterling apiece to be levied on their goods & Chattels Lands & Comm-ents for the use of the Lord prop^r afores^d - - - - -

The Condition of this Obligation is such that if the Aboud^r Elizab-th Col-bourne do^r of the good b^r haviour and ab^rar^r and make her personall app-arrained every Court during pleasure and if that her husband Lewis Col-bourne afores^d pay all Officers fees due from his said wife that then the above Obligation to be void otherwise to remain in full force & vertue et.
