of the Dominion of the R^t hono. Charles. Among Day 1689 that the afores^t Charles Williams
be fined One hundred pounds of tobacco according to the rules of Court for his contempt also
that he give sufficient security for his b^t halfe and paym^t officer fees et.

Now heretofore at this day (to witt) the 12th day of June as afores^t and the afores^t Charles Williams
with his Sureties John Taylor and William Fossett and in Open Court did acknowledg^t Thomas Ladd
to stand indebted unto the R^t hono. the Lord prop^{ty} viz^t the said Charles Williams in the sum^t of
Com pound sterl^t and John Taylor and William Fossett in the sum^t of five pounds sterl^t apaid
to be paid on their good^t Charles Ladd & C^t for the use of the Lord prop^{ty} afores^t

The sum^t being such that if the above bound (Charles Williams & of the good behaviour is
so to act^t during pleasure as also pay his fyre of one hundred pounds of tobacco upon
Demand with cost of suit then the above obligation to be void otherwise to remain in
full force power and vertue et.
