The Jurors for the R^t hono^{ble} the Lord prop^y at a grand Jury holden for the body of this County the second Tuesday in November last past doo present and find that Charles Williams of Poquoson hundred being pressed by William Innis Constable of the 5th Hundred to Conweigh and bring Jenckins wife to Matthew Jenckins Care of this County to testify in Opon Court in November last past) ag^t Richard Harrio & Susanna his wife in behalf of the Lord prop^y did wickedly and contumptuously deny and refuse to assist the said Constable tho' strictly therunto Comand'd ag^t the good Laws and justitutions of this Province and in Contempt of his Lordps Authority Wherefore his Lordps Attourney craved indgu-u way & Subrod ag^t the s^d Charles Williams according to Law in that Case provided et.
Upon which Law Charles Williams is forsd^e in his proper person and plead not guilty & for his Crayall put him-self to the Mercy of the Court.
Whereupon it is considered by this Court holden this day viz^t the 12th day of June in the viijth year of the Dominion of the R^t hono^{ble} Charles 2^d Annoq^{ue} Domij 1689 that the aforsd^e Charles Williams be fined One hundred pounds of Tobacco according to the rub^s of Court for his Contempt as also that he give sufficient s^curity for his b^ehaviour and paym^t of officers fees.
Now here at this day (to witt) the 12th day of June as aforsd^e Lawd the aforsd^e Charles Williams with his Sureties John Taylor and William Fossett and in Opon Court did acknowledge themselves to stand indsbld unto the R^t hono^{ble} the Lord prop^y viz^t the said Charles Williams in the sum of Com pound sterling) and John Taylor and William Fossett in the sum of five pounds Sterd. ap^{ie} to be s^cured on their goods & Chattels Land & Term^u for the use of the Lord prop^y aforsd^e the Condition being such that if the about bound Charles Williams be of the good b^ehaviour & so to abide during pleasure as also pay his fines of One hundred pounds of Tobacco upon Demand with Cost of Suite then the about Obligation to be void Otherwif to remaine in full force power and virtue et.
