Seal thereof & further you shall vs^e & demean yo^r self in y^e office of an attorney
in this Court according to yo^r best skill & knowledge; Soe helpe you God /

And further ordered that an attorney fee in any one Cause depending shall be allowed and paid
according to the rules of this Court to be proved by way of Common
