And Whereupon the pl.<sup>t</sup> Stephen Coston by his attorney John Taylor Court  
and says that in the year 1688 some times in October last past did buy  
of m. Henry Lynch def.<sup>t</sup> a man serv.<sup>t</sup> by name Richard Varding which serv.<sup>t</sup>  
the said Lynch def.<sup>t</sup> did sell and make sale for the full and just value  
of five thousand pounds of Tobacco and Casks for the just and full course  
of four years or three Months which said serv.<sup>t</sup> to give an assignment  
for doth utterly refused to give for the time aforesaid where by the  
said Coston is damnified to the value of 10000<sup>l</sup> of Tob.<sup>o</sup> & thereupon  
brings this Suit

And the def.<sup>t</sup> attorney Thomas Looke Coulyfe and defende the force of injury  
whon e.<sup>t</sup> and sayth that the pl.<sup>t</sup> his action he ought not to have for that the assignm.<sup>t</sup>  
which he declares for, for four years he always had ready to deliver to him, and as to y<sup>e</sup>  
three months more which he declares for and demands an assignm.<sup>t</sup> the def.<sup>t</sup> attorney  
further sayth that it would be time enough to sue for the same when the four years  
word expired

And the pl.<sup>t</sup> sayth he ought not to be debarred his action afores.<sup>d</sup> for then he sayth  
that he proffered the def.<sup>t</sup> if that he would rebate him three hundred pounds of Tob.<sup>o</sup>  
for the said three months service which he shuld him over and above the four years  
he would be satisfied being he would give him not assignm.<sup>t</sup> for the said time  
Upon which cause both parties and by mutual consent put themselves to the judgment of  
this Court Whereupon it is this day viz. the 13<sup>th</sup> day of June in the 10<sup>th</sup> year  
of the Dominion of the R.<sup>t</sup> hono<sup>ble</sup> Charles 2<sup>d</sup> Annoq. Dom. 1689 Considered by this Court  
here that the said Stephen Coston recover against the said Henry Lynch as w.<sup>th</sup> the  
sum of three hundred pounds of Tobacco for want of an assignm.<sup>t</sup> for the said three  
Months service and in full satisfaction of the same as also the sum  
of Tobacco left of suite and the Def.<sup>t</sup> in Moris e.<sup>t</sup>

And it is ordered by this Court that the said serv.<sup>t</sup> indentured be assigned and delivered  
to Stephen Coston e.<sup>t</sup>
