Whereas by Act of assembly entitled A further Additional Act to the Act for the advancement of trade: And to the supplementary Act for the same: It was enacted that from & after the last day of August 1600 no stilliards shall be used for the weighing any Tobacco ware or marchandized exceeding the weight of one hundred pounds in any of the Towns or Ports or places authorized for Towns but shall be weighed by weights & scales And to that end the Justices of each respective County Co^l was enjoined forthwith to send for & procure at the Charge of each respective County to be assessed in the County heavy substantiall scales and Lawfull weights weighing upwards of seven hundred pounds with three moveable post to be carried from place to place in the County or end this day to wit the xijth day of March Annoy^d Do^m 1607 The hon^{ble} The J^{ts} Deputies proclamation bearing date the fourth day of February last past was at the Court house (the Commission^{ers} then in Court sitting) Publicly proclaimed & reading the same
