After the deposition of John Duaper & Roger Burline being taken & ex^t upon oath doo finde that Mabell Bound hath made a contumelie ag^t his officer And therfore ord^t that she paye unto the Lord Prop^{ty} for Contumelie five hundred pounds of tobacco to have & to take her into Custodij until she give her selfe for payment of the same as affording her to y^r good behavior During pleasure the shrieffe to take security for the same in the summe of two hundred monys stell
