Proprietary and whereas the said Mabell Bound hath in contempt of his
Lopp^s Authority not onely refused and in spite contemned but also in contempt
of his Lopp^s officers detained & after severall times treated to surrender
to surrender up his Lopp^s prisoner vizt Katherine Conuulin alias Draper did
speake severall injurious words ag^t the Lower aforesaid by his Lopp^s in this
County and therefore his Lopp^s attorney Graue Judgem^t

After the Deposition of John Draper & Roger Burlin being taken & ex^o upon oathe doe finde
that Mabell Bound hath Comede a contempt ag^t Authority And therefore ord^r that she
pay unto the Lord Proprietary for Contempt five hundred pounds of tobacco the sh^d to take
her into Custody untill she give security for paym^t of the same ab also y^e sh^d L^o of y^e good
behaviour Inuring pleasure the shenke to take security for the same in the summe of ten pounds
money sent.
