Hon.ble. the Lord Prop. in that the said Drigger hath shamefully and wilfully committed the sin of fornication and upon the body of y<sup>e</sup> said wife hath gott a bastard child contrary to y<sup>e</sup> Lawes of Almighty god the Constitution of this Province & well knowne scandal of his Sopp. good people & therefore his Sopp. attorney Council Judgment of the said Devereux abin Sopp. in y<sup>e</sup> case provided. La. Sanguis C. Indit

And the said Devereux appearing & yeeling himselfe guilty who affirmed before the 16<sup>th</sup> of the 1<sup>st</sup> of the 1<sup>st</sup> was the father of the child & this 16<sup>th</sup> of the 1<sup>st</sup> of the 1<sup>st</sup> is that y<sup>e</sup> said Devereux is the father of the said child borne of the body of y<sup>e</sup> said wife & ord. that the said Devereux be of the good abearance during the pleasure of the Court for maintenance of y<sup>e</sup> child to impurchase the County the child to be paid in charge
