withwhercof I have here unto sett my hand & scale this Twentieth second day of April Anno Domini 1607 in the Eleventh year of the Dominion of the R: honorable Charles the first over Maryland
The Condition of this obligation is such that if the above mentioned bounden James Baxter his heires executor adm: or assignee shall paye: or cause to be paid well & truly unto the above said Francis Jenkinson his heires executor administrators assignee or Certain Attorney the full & Just Summe of Twenty seven pound four shilling at some one convenient Towne in the aforesaid County of Somerset in the Province of Maryland with out fraud or Cozen at the Current rate at monye now goeth both in the aforesaid Province as also in the Kingdom of England at the exchequer hereof at or before y: tenth day of November next ensuing the Date hereof in Current monye sterling that then this present obligation to be void and of none effect otherwise to stand & remaine in full force power & virtue
