See the Jurors find that the Jewellm<sup>er</sup> ey<sup>e</sup> Henry Smith is void by examination of  
Henry Phillips which declares that he did not see Henry Smith loose the said horse  
from the Court

See the Jurors find by information of Ju<sup>r</sup> Colhoun that Ju<sup>r</sup> Elliot Jur<sup>or</sup> hath stole  
Three barrowes marked with a swallow fork under bitt & over bitt on the right yard  
& a top & slitt on the left eard Mary Elliot & her son W<sup>m</sup> Shollitto witnesses this done  
the 3<sup>rd</sup> day of Aprill last 1688

See the Jurors find by common fame declared by Rob<sup>t</sup> Hall that W<sup>m</sup> Ju<sup>r</sup> Loader hath  
forged a bill of eight hundred pound of Tobacco or thereabouts ag<sup>t</sup> Phillip Senior

The examination of Mary Elliot at County Court June the 13<sup>th</sup> 1688  
John Elliot Jun<sup>r</sup> sometimes in March last did kill 2 shoats of about 1/2 year old on the  
same Mouth of March the afores<sup>d</sup> Ju<sup>r</sup> Elliot Jun<sup>r</sup> did kill a ground squirrel barrow  
of about 2 or 3 year old Capt Delitt under head of one eard & the other eard  
whole in ditto Mount he killed two shoats of about half a year old & the other eard  
slitt in one eard & the other eard over halved in same Mount & two barrowes marked  
with top & slitt of one eard & swallow fork of the other the 3<sup>rd</sup> day of Aprill last  
shoats of 1/2 year old or thereabouts of the same mark & when he had killed the  
hoggs he wd burn y<sup>e</sup> gutts & bury the haye in the ground &c
