Law & otherom it sheweth that whereas divers & sundry persons within this province
Contracting debto by acco. with merchants & others for w^{ch} they stand & remaine Oudly
Debito. Upon their Books of Acco. the w^{ch} they be homestly & well disposed to pay
the same upon demand first had & required of the said Debtor by the said Creditors or other
person lawfull Authorizd to receive the same without co. it is impossible for the Debtor
to know where or to whom to pay the said Debts yet vnderr of the Creditors through
vexation & quarition hums. doe daily comone their suits at Law ag. such their
Debito. without any demand of such their Debts of their said Debts whereby their said
Debt is much increased. thes. Debtor thereby greatly burthened & impoverished
by meane of such their vexation & vniust suits in Law & therfore it was enacted
by the Lord prop. & that after the 20th day of December next no person whatsoeuer his
executo. or dñe. living or crediting into this province shall for any debt due or owing
to him by acco. Upon book or otherwise & for w^{ch} the Debtor hath not paid his hand
of feale to such his Creditors shall sue or implead at Law such Debts. for any such
debts contracted as aforesaid & under hand & seal of such Debts aforesaid. vnde
he shall first demand & require the same of the said Debtor in the County where he shall
judgett if al his plantation & ffor thor by leauing thereof under the hand of such
Creditors or thos. he shall impower to receive the same when due & to whom the same shall
be paid & if therepon the same be not accordingly paid then it shall may be
lawfull for the sd. creditor to sue & implead such his Debtor for the said debt & recover
ag. him all such cost & damages as upon Legall Crysall in any Court of this province
shall be adjudged ag. him & incas. Any person shall sue or implead any such his
Debts as aforesd. Contrary to this Act he shall los. all his cost of such his suit
to be Leyable to satisfie such his Debts. all such damages that shall accrue unto the
said Debtor by such his vexation & vniust suits at Law. All w^{ch} the aboue said
Henry Smith hath not don therfore the before named the iugmt. of the law if the
aboue Henry Smith his Accion ag. him ought to have

Now at this day to cert the 14th day of June aforesd the said parties by their Attorneys
aforesd Lane & the said Henry Smith having afterward produced a receipt vnder his
