Now at this day to wit the 15th day of August as aforesaid was brought the Ophault of the
said Jenckin Morrie decessed in open Court as also the petitioners aforesaid
Lanc^r Marmaduck Myster desired to have the boy called Jenckin Morrie until he came to
the age of one and twenty years of age & in consideration thereof he would teach the said
Jenckin Morrie the Trade of a Cammer as also he would teach the said Jenckin Morrie to read &
write & that during the said Term & time he is to putt^{him} to no other work than the Learning work

Frances Morrie until she came to the age of sixteen years or the day of her Marriadge
& in consideration thereof he would give each of them at the expiration of the said Term
& time a two year old heffer which was granted him & confirmed here in Court -
