damified & hath Loss to the value of 120^l of Cob^{ts} & thereupon brings his suit

Whereupon Sam^r Thomas Millman def^t by his Attorney Thomas Poole doth defend
the force & injury of the pl^t & saith that he never had any Cow or Yearling of the pl^t in
his custody as in manner & form declared the def^t put the pl^t to the proof of his
Declaration Upon which came both parties by their Attorneys aforesaid & by Mutuall
Consent put themselves to the iudgment of this Court

Now at this day to wit the 16th day of August as aforesaid this Court giving No^t Acco^{nt}
nor proofs on the pl^t side ordered that the pl^t take nothing by his writt but a non
suit granted to the def^t ag^t the said pl^t & the said pl^t to be in Mercy for his false

1686 then the said Thomas became indebted unto the said George in the sume of Nyn^e

produced which sume of Nyn^e hundred & sixty pounds & a halfe of Cob^{ts} the said
Thomas hath refused to pay & still doth refuse although often therunto required where
upon the pl^t saith he is damified & hath Loss to the value of fourteen hundred pounds
