And whereupon the pl^{aintiff} by James Langster his Attourney James & saies that he the said pl^{aintiff} had severall Chaulke running at the house of the said D^eff^{endant} one black cow with a star in her forehead mark^d by Rowland Beving with her mercase and one heifer with her mercase one steer of three year^{old} and one yearling heifer and one calf which said cattle the pl^{aintiff} had & was possessed with by his intermarriage with his late wife Mary Butcher and raised at the plantation of the said D^eff^{endant} but he the said D^eff^{endant} fraudulently & craftily intending to deceive the pl^{aintiff} of the foresaid cattle hath mark^d the said mercases of the said cattle in his own mark^s & them unjustly & unlawfully from the pl^{aintiff} the cost of him demanded wherefore the pl^{aintiff} says he is damnified & hath lost for want of the said cattle to the value of three thousand pound of Cob^{alt} & thereupon brings his suite
