Whereupon Command was given to the Sheriff of this County to cause to come next Tuesday good and Lawfull men of his Bayliwick by whom the Truth of the matter might be the better known which being done The parties aforesaid came by their Attorneys aforesaid And the Jurors of that Jury likewise (to wit) Samuel Collins Francis Joynt Robert Touch Thomas Eyre John Ritehmo Joseph Stator John namoly Marquand Mackier Nathaniel Wozey Walter Wood John Christopher & Richard Samuellic who to say the truth in the premises being Elected Trayed & Sworn upon their Oath the day wee the Jurors doe find for the plaintiff & which Verdict was ordered to be Entored upon which time the aforesaid Henry Smith do<sup>t</sup> & Gaude an Appeal to the Justices of the Superior Court which was granted him giving security according to Law &c

The same Day Com<sup>t</sup> aforesaid Ordered that the Constables of the severall and respective <sup>hundreds</sup> take the Non residents of each hundred in their Custody viz<sup>t</sup> the Constable of the hundred where any Non resident as aforesaid is, that the said Constable take him or them into his Custody & him or them safe keep until they give good & sufficient security as well for the paying of their Taxes as for their behavio<sup>r</sup> &c This Court adjourned to the second Tuesday in September Next
