Ordered that Charles Williams of the said town be taken into the Sheriff's custody for to in his personall appearance next Court is bring for his contumacy in not bringing his daughter of Richard Harris to Court as being prest by the Constable of that hundred to bring her bound as an Evidence for the R. t hono. the Lord pro p' against Richard Harris & Susannah his wife — It is further Ordered that William Elmie Constable appear next Court to present the aforesd Charles Williams for his Contumacy as aforesd & on his behalf of the R. t hono. the Lord pro.

Ordered Execution to issue against John Webb for his contumacy in not appearing his personall appearance at the house of William Morris as being shew unto him whereby to order him what work he was bound to the Court and for the use of the County of Cheshire it being 20 da

Ordered that William Eggleston pay unto William Morris of this County £1000 for his services as being adm'r of William Eggleston late of this County deceased who was bound to him for the said services as being due from said Morris or his County wife if not already paid by the said Eggleston deceased to be made appearable this Court Ac.

All a County Court held this 14th day of November 1688 present (as above) as aforesaid The petition of William Jones Junr. showing that Petitioner is a Servt of this County & is willing to let your petitioner have her son Peter Thomas Stevens now aged thirteen years & to let him have his age of County one year & your petitioner fearing that recognizances may be taken thereof in this County = Whereas it was Ordered that the said William Jones Junr. have the aforesaid Stevens Stevens until he comes to the age of County and years as aforesaid & that he bring up in the service of God and that he put him to school for a good or two to three sound Education etc.

Ordered that John Perkins serve as a constable for this ensuing year in Scornford hundred in the town of Daniel Donahoe first taking the usual Oath of Constableness before one of his Lordships Justices of the peace for this County of Shropshire Ac.

Ordered by this Court that Isaac Hobson of this County serve as a constable for this ensuing year in Crammes six hundred first taking the usual Oath of Constableness before one of his Lordships Justices of the peace for this County of Shropshire Ac.

Ordered this day being the 14th day of November as aforesaid by this Court that Richard Coffield of this County Officer and Servt as a constable for Nanticoke hundred for this ensuing year first taking the usual Oath of Constableness before one of his Lordships Justices of the peace of this County of Shropshire

Ordered by this Court that Henry Miles of this County of Shropshire Officer and Servt as a constable for this ensuing year in Moncakin hundred first taking the usual Oath of Constableness before one of his Lordships Justices of the peace for this County of Shropshire Ac.

Ordered by this Court that William Nelson of this County of Shropshire Officer and Servt as a constable for this ensuing year in Mattupamdy hundred first taking the usual Oath of Constableness before one of his Lordships Justices of the peace for this County

Ordered that William Eggleston of this County of Shropshire Officer and Servt as a constable for this ensuing year in Wiccecombe hundred first taking the usual Oath of Constableness before one of his Lordships Justices of the peace for this County

The petition of Andrew Spee making appear to this Court now that he lost some hoggis and that for charging of Cheshire highway with his flocks, his master in Law Thomas Loole hath most grievously and absurdly abused your petitioner John West & George Etherden and witnesseth to his railing words your petitioner prayeth that he may give security for his good behaviour for that he standeth in bond of his life of the said Loole = And the said Andrew Spee & Edward the parson of the said Cheshire John West standeth in his bonds of said Loole —

Ordered that Thomas Loole give security for his good behaviour but charging his bond was omitted
