Ordered execution to issue against John Webb for his contempt in not making his personall appearance at the house of William Morrie as being sherevulo summoned whereby to order him what work he was bound to this Court and for the use of the County of Sumersett being 20 d. for Elco Connoway &c.

Ordered that William Elgato pay unto William Morrie of this County the said works as being adm. of William Elgato's adm. of this County & also who was bound to this Court for the said works as being due from said Morrie of this County & also if not already paid by the said Elgato & also to be made appear to this Court &c.

At a County Court holden the 11th Day of November 1688 present the Court as aforesaid The petition of William Jones Jun. showing that Rebecca Shorne of this County Widow is willing to let new p. tioneer have her son called Thomas Shorne now aged seven years until he attains to the age of twenty one year & your p. tioneer praying that recognizance may be taken thereof in this Court = Whereupon it was ordered that the said William Jones Jun. have the aforesaid Thomas Shorne until he cometh to the age of twenty one year as aforesaid & that he bring up in the fear of God and that he put him to school for upward or two to three years Education &c.

Ordered that John Portins be sworn as a Constable for this ensuing year in Bocombe hundred in the county of Dorset first taking the usual Oath of Constableness before one of his Lordships Justices of the Peace for this County of Sumersett &c.

Ordered by this Court that Isaac Horsey of this County be sworn as a Constable for this ensuing year in Ammansix hundred first taking the usual Oath of Constableness before one of his Lordships Justices of the Peace for this County of Sumersett &c.

Ordered this day being the 14th Day of November as aforesaid by this Court that Richard Pofford of this County Offitiare and be sworn as a Constable for Nanticoke hundred for this ensuing year first taking the usual Oath of Constableness before one of his Lordships Justices of the Peace of this County of Sumersett &c.

Ordered by this Court that Henry Miles of this County of Sumersett Offitiare be sworn as a Constable for this ensuing year in Moncakin hundred first taking the usual Oath of Constableness before one of his Lordships Justices of the Peace for this County of Sumersett &c.

Ordered by this Court that William Nelson of this County of Sumersett Offitiare be sworn as a Constable for this ensuing year in Mattupamby hundred first taking the usual Oath of Constableness before one of his Lordships Justices of the Peace for this County &c.

Ordered that William Elgato of this County of Sumersett Offitiare and be sworn as a Constable for this ensuing year in Wicocemoco hundred first taking the usual Oath of Constableness before one of his Lordships Justices of the Peace for this County &c.

The petition of Andrew Speer making appear to this Court now that he lost some hogs and that for charging of Chouac highway with the felony his father in Law Thomas Poole hath most grievously and absurdly abused your p. tioneer John West & George Archer and witnesses to his treating words your p. tioneer praying that he may give security for his good behaviour for that he stand in fear of his life of the said Poole = Came the said Andrew Speer & Edward the peace of the said Chouac Poole John West & Archer on behalf of said Speer =

Ordered that Thomas Poole give security for his good behaviour but praying hearing was omitted.
