Whereupon it is this day to witt the 14th day of Nov-ber ad aforesaid considered by this Court that the said Richard Whitty recover against the said John Pools the sum of six hundred pounds of Coban debt recovered and also the sum of cost of Suits & the def.^t in Mercy &c.

The petition of William Elgato of this County showing that Margaret Morrie the wife of Jonckin Morrie late of this County decessed is indebted to your petitioner in the last sum of two hundred pounds of pork for two gallons of Rum at forty pounds of pork ff gallon which the said Margaret had of your petitioner for which your said petitioner craves an order for the said out of the estate of the said decessed Cause William Elgato to swear in open Court upon the holy Evangelist that the said sum is his just debt and due to him & that he never received nor part nor parcel thereof Upon which it was ordered that Thomas Gordon ad adu. of the estate of the said Jonckin Morrie & Margaret his wife decessed the aforesaid sum of two hundred pounds of pork out of the estate of the said decessed unto William Elgato aforesaid &c.
