In that case m^r. Stephen Luff was appointed to audit all accounts and regulate the damages
of the action depending between Alexander Thomas admt^r and Thomas Saraword
Comake report thereof to this Court

Now at this day (to wit) the Eleventh day of December anno aforesaid came the aforesaid
Stephen Luff and made this returne November the 8th 1688

I do find and judge that Thomas Saraword ought to pay unto Alexander Thomas one thousand
pounds of tobacco for cost and damages &c - Stephen Luff -
which Verdict being read was approved off by this Court and Ordered to be entered & confirmed

Ordered that William Bramond Bryanney and Francis Thomas be Summons to appear
the next Court to answer to such things as shall be Objected against them &c - - -

Came Francis Jenkinson and made Appare to this Court by vertue of a Bill under the hand
and Seal of Jenkinson Morris Esq^r of this County dated that the said Jenkinson Morris before
his decease becaus indebt^d to him the said Francis Jenkinson in the summe of Three hundred
fifty and one pounds of tobacco as per said Bill hereon Court produced both Appare and whereas
the said Francis Jenkinson had an Order for the said 351 lbs ayt^r the sume of the said
Jenkinson Morris afores^d And the said Francis Jenkinson having Sworne in Open Court that the
said debt of 351 lbs was due to him & that he never receid noe partie nor parcell therof
It was then ordered that Thomas Gordon adm^r of the estate of the said Jenkinson
Morris dide pay unto the afores^d Francis Jenkinson the sume of Three hundred fifty & one
pounds of tobacco &c

Came Daniel Haste and had an Order acy^r the estate of Jenkinson Morris Esq^r of
this County doct^r for One hundred and sixtie pounds of porke which the said Morris owid him
as per Acc^c hereon Court produced viz:

To One gale ^r of Rum at	40	per gale ^r
To 2 gale ^r of Rum at	80	160. of porke
To 1 gale ^r of Rum at	40	

Whereupon it was Ordered that Thomas Gordon adm^r of this estate afores^d pay unto Daniel
Haste One hundred & sixtie pounds of porke &c

Came Nicholas Fountain & George Saine in Open Court did acknowledge thems^e selves
each of them to stand indebted unto the R^t hono^r the Lord Proprietary in the sume of Twenty
pounds flor^s ap^c to be & leaved on their goods & chattels & to reme^r for the use afores^d
The condition being such that if Thomas Cooke of this County be of the good behav^r
A warrant towards all his Lordships good people and especially towards Andrew Speer then
the above Obligation to be void otherwise to remain in force &c
