Upon w<sup>ch</sup> it was ordered that John Gelly aforesaid have the boy called John Morrio aforesaid son to Jenkin Morrio late of this County) vntill the said John Morrio attained to the years or age of twenty one years and that the said John Gelly give him a few shillings yearly and also to learn him the said John Morrio to read and bring him up in the feare of God w<sup>ch</sup> he promised in Court

Ordered that Francis Jenkin Sheriff of this County take into his custody John Kemp and him safe keep vntill security given ad w<sup>ch</sup> for his behavio<sup>r</sup> ad for his appearance next Court
