X. AND BE IT ENACTED, That the inhabitants of the faid town of Princess-Anne, or a majority be appointed. of them, shall have full power and authority, at any time between the first day of January, eighteen &c. hundred and one, and the first day of May of the same year, to appoint a patroller for the said town and precincts, and to direct him in the execution of his duty, and to levy on the inhabitants of faid town annually, a fum of money, not exceeding forty dollars, to be paid to faid patroller as a compensation for his services.

XI. AND BE IT ENACTED, That the faid patroller shall have full power to summon any number Who may summer of the inhabitants of the faid town or precincts to affift him in the execution of the duties of his faid and persons, whose duty it shall be to attend the faid patroller up &c. office, so often as he may think it necessary, whose duty it shall be to attend the said patroller, under the penalty of five dollars for every neglect or refufal, to be recovered before any justice of the peace as other small debts are recoverable.

act for building a new gaol in Baltimore county.
