an additional section to be designated 'Section 6,' subsection 'Protecting Public Improvements.'"

On motion of Mr. Sandman

Leave was granted to the Committee on Ways and Means to introduce a bill entitled "An Act providing for the erection and operation of a rock crushing plant by and under the supervision of the board of directors and the officers of the Maryland House of Correction, and providing for the sale of the crushed stone product to the counties and other municipalities of the State."

On motion of Mr. Waters.

Leave was granted to the Committee on Judiciary to introduce a bill entitled "An Act to amend Article 93, of the Code of Public General Laws of Maryland, title Testamentary Law,' by adding a new sub-section to said Article under the title Fees on estates under five hundred dollars,' said section to follow section 80 of said Article, and to be designated as Section 80 A."

Leave was granted to the Committee on Judiciary to introduce a bill entitled "An Act to make the fee charged for the service of any stallion or jackass, whose owner is duly licensed to stand the same, a lien on the mare served, and on her progeny from said service, until the fee is paid."
