Leave was granted to the Committee on Corporations to introduce a bill entitled "An Act to incorporate the Investment Company of Baltimore county."

On motion of Mr. Long,

Leave was granted to the Committee on Ways and Means to introduce a bill entitled "An Act to repeal section 146 D, of Article 81, of the Code of Public General Laws of Maryland, entitled 'Revenue and Taxes,' as said section is enacted and added to said Article 81 by chapter 275 and chapter 501, of the Acts of the General Assembly of Maryland, passed at its January Session in the year 1898, and to re-enact said section 146 D with amendments."

On motion of Mr. Contee,

Leave was granted to the Prince George's county delegation to introduce a bill entitled "An Act to repeal sections 86 A, 86 B, 86 D, of Article 17 of the Code of Public Local Laws, title 'Prince George's County,' sub-title 'County Commissioners,' being chapter 312 of the Acts of the General Assembly of Maryland, passed in the year 1892, and to re-enact the same with amendments."
