Senate bill entitled "An Act to repeal sections 252 and 353, of the Code of Public Local Laws, title 'City of Baltimore,' sub-title 'Courts,' sub-division 'Orphans' Court,' as repealed and re-enacted by chapter 123, of the Acts of 1898, and to re-enact the said sections with amendments."

Which was read a first time and referred to the Baltimore city delegation.

Senate bill entitled "An Act to add an additional section to Article 4, of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland, title 'City of Baltimore,' sub-title 'Miscellaneous Local Laws,' said section to follow immediately after section 623, and to be designated 'Section 623 A."

Which was read a first time and referred to the Baltimore city delegation.

Senate bill No. 215, entitled "An Act to amend the charter of the Modern Language Association of America, of Baltimore city, a body corporate, duly incorporated under the General Laws of the State of Maryland."
