Leave was granted to the Committee on the Judiciary, to introduce a bill entitled "An Act to sanction the bequest of \$500 to St. John's Evangelical Lutheran Church at Hagerstown, Maryland, contained in the last will and testament of Mary A. Knodle, late of Washington county, Maryland."

On motion of Mr. Hopkins,

Leave was granted to the Harford county delegation, to introduce a bill entitled "An Act to repeal section 185 of Article 13, of the Code of Public Local Laws, title 'Harford County,' sub-title 'Havre de Grace,' and to reenact the same with amendments."

On motion of Mr. Jeffers,

Leave was granted to the Baltimore county delegation to introduce a bill entitled "An Act to authorize the Clerk of the Circuit Court for Baltimore county to have prepared new equity indexes of the equity docket in his office."
