The following Acts of the General Assembly of Maryland, originating in the House of Delegates, were presented to the Governor for his approval this day, at 3 o'clock P. M.

Chapter 103. "An Act to provide for an additional justice of the peace in and for the eighth election district in Carroll county."

Chapter 104. "An Act to amend sections 1 and 2 of chapter 344, of the Acts of 1896, entitled 'An Act to incorporate the Fraternal Trust and Banking Company, so that the corporate title of the said corporation shall hereafter be the 'City Trust and Banking Company,' and further amending said Act so as to authorize the election of twenty-five directors or less."

Chapter 105. "An Act to authorize and direct the County Commissioners of Washington county to levy a sum of money to refund to David Wolfs heir's of said county, certain taxes erroneously paid by them."

Chapter 106. "An Act to repeal section 332 of Article 22, of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland, title 'Washington County,' sub-title 'Roads,' and to re-enact the same with amendments."

Chapter 107. "An Act to authorize and direct the County Commissioners of Washington county, to levy a sum of money to refund to Daniel W. Richard of said county, certain taxes erroneously paid by him."
