House bill entitled "An Act to add a new section to Article 4, of the Code of Public Local Laws, title 'City of Baltimore,' sub-title 'Police Commissioners,' to follow section 745, and to be designated as 'Section 745 A.'"

Said unfavorable report was adopted.

Also unfavorably,

House bill, entitled "An Act to add new sections to Article 27, of the Code of Public General Laws, title 'Crimes and Punishments,' to come in after section 4 B, and to be called 'Adulteration of Extracted Honey,' sections 4 C, 4 D, 4 E and 4 F."

Said unfavorable report was adopted.
