Senate bill entitled "An Act to amend Article 11, of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland, title 'Frederick County,' by inserting after section 139, under a new sub-title to be designated 'Fees of Officers,' certain additional sections, to be known as '139 A and 139 B,' regulating certain fees to be paid to the sheriff of Frederick county, and to the county constables of said county."

Senate bill entitled "An Act to repeal section 25, of Article 20, of the Code of Public General Laws of Maryland, title 'Constables,' sub-title 'Duties of Constables,' in so far as the same relates to Frederick county."

House bill entitled "An Act to add an additional section to Article 1, of the Code of Public Local Laws, title 'Allegany County,' sub-title 'Intoxicating Liquors,' to follow section 175 B, and to be designated as 'Section 175 B B.'"
