

The Secretary of the Senate appeared and delivered the following message :

House bill entitled "An Act to repeal and re-enact with amendments section 1, of Article 17. of the Code of Public Local Laws, title 'Clerks of Courts,' and to re-enact the same with amendments so far as the same applies to Talbot county."

AMENDMENTS PROPOSED.

On lines 4 and 5, of section 1, strike out the words "so far as the same applies to Talbot county."

In line 20, section 1, strike out the words "Talbot county," and insert after the word "for," in line 20, section 1, the following :

"The respective counties or the Supreme Bench of Baltimore city, as the case may be."

In lines 3 and 4 of title, strike out the words "far as the same applies to Talbot county."

Which were severally read and concurred in.

The bill, as amended, was then passed by yeas and nays, as follows :
