House bill entitled "An Act to incorporate the Garrett County Telephone Company."

Which was read a first time and referred to the Committee on Corporations.

Also,

Senate bill No. 173, entitled "An Act to submit to the legal and qualified voters of the town of Lonaconing, in Allegany county, Maryland, the question whether or not certain additional sections should be added to chapter 435, of the Acts of 1893, amendatory of the Acts of 1890, chapter 132, entitled an Act to incorporate the town of Lonaconing, in Allegany county."

Which was read a first time and referred to the Allegany county delegation.

Also,

Senate bill entitled "An Act to prevent persons from using the side walks, pavements or alleys of the First and Third precincts of the Fifth Election District for bicycle riding, and to require persons riding bicycles in said precincts between a half hour after sunset and a half hour before sunrise, to have upon their bicycles a bell and lighted lantern."

Which was read a first time and referred to the Anne Arundel county delegation.

Also,

House bill entitled "An Act to prohibit the sale of spirituous or fermented liquors within one and one-half miles of Providence Methodist Protestant church, at Kemptown Election District No. 9, of Frederick county, Maryland."

Endorsed: "Read the third time and passed by yeas and nays."

Also,

House bill entitled "An Act to consolidate the corporations, known as 'The Trustees of the Methodist Episcopal Church, called Eden Chapel,' and the William Waters' Memorial Methodist Episcopal Church of Harford county, and to enlarge the power of consolidated corporation."
