House bill entitled "An Act to abolish the payment of appearance fees to attorneys-at-law, by the County Commissioners of Baltimore county in 'Habeas Corpus' cases arising in said county."

House bill entitled "An Act to authorize and empower the Druid Ridge Cemetery of Baltimore county, to purchase, hold or use for the purposes of burial two hundred acres of land in said county, and to perpetuate the charter."

AMENDMENT PROPOSED.

At the end of section 2, add the following words:

"Provided that nothing herein contained shall be construed to exempt the property hereinbefore mentioned from taxation."
