House bill entitled "An Act to add a new section to Article 81 of the Code of Public General Laws of Maryland, title 'Revenue and Taxes,' to be designated as 'Section 204,' to follow section 203 of said Article, and to repeal all Acts or parts of Acts, laws or parts of laws in conflict with the provisions of this Act, so far as the same may be in conflict."

Which unfavorable report was adopted.

Senate bill entitled "An Act to authorize the apportionment of an agent or agents to prosecute the claims of the State of Maryland against the government of the United States, and to provide the method of his compensation."

Which was read a second time.

Senate bill entitled "An Act to appropriate a sum of money to meet the deficiency for the printing of the General Assembly of 1900."
