Mr. Choate, from Select Committee, reported unfavorably,

House bill entitled "An Act to repeal chapter 196, of the Acts of 1896, entitled "An Act to prohibit the issuing of any license for the sale of spirituous or fermented liquors or lager beer within one mile of Public School No. 2, located at Evergreen, etc."

Which unfavorable report was adopted.
