Senate bill entitled "An Act to add an additional section to section 44, of Article 14, of Volume 2, of the Code of Public Local Laws, title 'Howard County,' sub-title 'County Commissioners and County Collectors,' to be known and designated as 'Section 44 F.'"

Which was read a first time and referred to the Howard county delegation and Mr. Keys.

Senate bill entitled "An Act to authorize the County Commissioners of Caroline county to issue bonds to an amount not exceeding the sum of \$8,000 for the purpose of rebuilding a part of Dover Bridge, and to levy a tax on the assessable property of Caroline county for the payment of the same."

Which was read a first time and referred to the Caroline county delegation and Mr. Clark.

Senate bill entitled "An Act to authorize and direct the County Commissioners of Prince George's county to construct a public county road upon and along Washington Turnpike road between Laurel and line of District of Columbia, to borrow money on the credit of said county, for the construction of said road and issue coupon bonds therefor; and to levy and collect on and from the assessable property of said county an annual tax sufficient to
