Which was read a first time and referred to the Talbot county delegation.

Also,

Senate bill entitled "An Act to amend the charter and extend the powers of the Frederick County Telephone and Telegraph Company, a corporation formed under Article 23, of the Code of Public General Laws of Maryland, entitled 'Corporations,' the said charter being recorded in one of the Records of Corporation of Frederick county, in Liber No. 2, Folio 401, by adding two Articles to said charter."

Which was read a first time and referred to the Committee on Corporations.

Also,

Senate bill entitled "An Act to repeal sections 1, 2 and 3 of chapter 458, of the Acts of 1894, entitled 'An Act to authorize the County Commissioners of Caroline and Talbot counties to appropriate sums of money for the purpose of maintaining and keeping in safe repair and condition for public travel, Dover Bridge and causeways leading thereto, connecting Talbot and Caroline counties, and to re-enact the same with amendments."
