House bill entitled "An Act to repeal section 448, of the Acts of 1898, chapter 123, entitled 'City of Baltimore Charter,' and to re-enact said section 448 under the head of 'Fire Department,' with amendments, so as to read as follows'"

Which was read a first time.

Also, favorably,

House bill entitled "An Act directing the Appeal Tax Court of Baltimore city, not to issue any permit for the erection of new buildings in said city until all taxes due are paid on the land upon which said buildings are to be erected."

Which was read a first time.

Also, fovorably,

House bill entitled "An Act to add additional sections to Article 4, of the Code of Public Local Laws, title 'City of Baltimore,' as repealed and re-enacted by chapter 123, of the Acts of the General Assembly of Maryland, session 1898, sub-title 'Miscellaneous Local Laws,' sub-title 'Police Commissioners,' sub-title 'Special Fund,' to follow section 776, and to be known as 'Sections 776 A, 776 B, 776 C, 776 D, 776 E and 776 F.'"

Which was read a first time.

Also, favorably, with proposed amendments,

House bill entitled "An Act to add three additional sections to Article 4, of the Code of Public Local Laws, title 'City of Baltimore,' to be known as sub-title 'Atatachments,' section 73 AA, and section 73 BB, and section 73 CC."
