AMENDMENTS PROPOSED.

At the end of Section 1, insert and add the words "engaged in life, health or accident insurance business."

In line 8, (same section,) after word "may," strike out the word "except," and insert word "accept."

In section 5, line 6, insert the word "the" after the word "stockholder."

In section 7, line 5, after the word "State," insert the words "so far as the same may be necessary for the purposes of this Act and not contrary to or in conflict with the provisions thereof."
