Leave was granted to the Baltimore city delegation to introduce a bill entitled "An Act to authorize the Board of Police Commissioners of Baltimore city to increase the pensions of Herman Heimeller, Wm. J. Lourdenslager, John Davis, Jno. T. Kelly, Ambrose A. Ryan, Alexander Slayman, Jno. A. Watts, Joseph S. Townsend, retired policemen of the police force of Baltimore city."
