

Senate bill entitled "An Act to declare the sanction of the General Assembly of Maryland to the several deeds made by Samuel Appold and wife, Gabriel D. Clark and wife and Wm. Kammerer, to the Trustees of St. Mary's English Evangelical Lutheran Church of Baltimore, a corporation duly incorporated under the laws of the State of Maryland, and also to the acquisition hereafter by the said grantor of the fee simple title to any lot of ground mentioned in said deeds in which it has thereby acquired less than a fee simple, and to the selling, mortgaging, leasing or other disposition thereof."
