Mr. Latrobe, from the Committee on Ways and Means reported unfavorably,

House bill entitled "An Act to accurately re-establish the boundary line between the State of Maryland and the State of Pennsylvania, commonly called 'Mason and Dixon's Line,' and to re-mark the same wherever necessary with suitable monuments, and to make an appropriation therefor."

Said instalment being the apportionment made to said Garrett county on the 15th day of March in each year.
