Senate bill entitled "An Act to provide a special fund as authorized by chapter 123, section 2 of the Acts of the General Assembly of Maryland, session 1898, title 'City of Baltimore,' sub-title 'Charter,' sub-title 'General Powers,' sub-title 'Police,' and to care for and regulate the distribution of said fund."

Which was read a first time and referred to the Committee on Judiciary.

Also,

Senate bill entitled "An Act to repeal and re-enact with amendments chapter 494, of the Acts of the General Assembly of Maryland, session 1898, to repeal section 756, of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland title 'Baltimore City,' sub-title 'Police,' and to re-enact the same with amendments."

Which was read a first time and referred to the Committee on Judiciary.

Senate bill entitled "An Act to add a new section to Article 2 of the Code of Public Local Laws, title 'Anne Arundel County,' sub-title 'Circuit Court,' to be designated 'Sections 108 A, 108 B, 108 C and 108 D,' authorizing the appointment of a stenographer clerk to the grand jury and defining his duties, obligations and pay."
