the Old National Pike or Green street extended, in said city, and to provide for the grading, paving or macademizing, sewering, and otherwise improving said Fayette street and the extension of the same commonly known as 'Sulpher Spring Hollow Road,' within the proposed extended corporate limits and to provide for the payment of the costs of said improvement."

Which was read a second time and ordered to be engrossed for a third reading.
