Senate bill entitled "An Act to repeal sections 91, of Article 25, title 'County Commissioners,' sub-title 'Public Roads,' of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland, so far as the same applies to Wicomico county."

Which was read a first time, and referred to the Wicomico county delegation.

Also,

Senate bill entitled "An Act to add certain new sections to Article 4, of the Code of Public Local Laws, title 'City of Baltimore, sub-title 'Police Commissioners,' providing for the creation of a Board of Police Examiners for the City of Baltimore, defining and prescribing the duties thereof, and regulating appointments promotions, reductions in rank, transfers in and removal from the police force of said city, said sections to follow section 745, and to be designated as 'Sections 745 A, 745 B, 745 C, 745 D, 745 E and 745 F.'"

Which was read the first time, and referred to the Committee on Judiciary.
