

House bill entitled "An Act to declare the sanction and consent of the General Assembly of Maryland to the bequest contained in the last will and testament of Wm. R. Acton, late of Charles county, deceased, of \$100, to and for the use and benefit of the Vestry of Port Tobacco Parish, under the name of the Vestry of St. Paul's P. E. Church."

Also, favorably,

House bill entitled "An Act to add three new sections to Article 12, of the Code of Public Local Laws, title 'Garrett County,' sub-title 'Jurors,' providing for the selection and drawing of jurors in said county, said sections to follow 127, and to be designated as 'Sections 127 A, 127 B and 127 C.'"

House bill entitled "An Act to give all wages due and owing to any employee for services rendered to any railroad company operating in the State of Maryland, priority of all other claims.

House bill entitled "An Act giving the consent of the State of Maryland to the acquisition by purchase or condemnation by the United States of a lot or parcel of land in the city of Westminster in Carroll county, Maryland, for the purpose of erecting thereon a building for a post-office.
