AMENDMENTS PROPOSED.

(1.) Amend by adding the word "willfully," after the word "shall" in line 10 of said bill.

(2.) Amend by striking out the words "pickered or wall-eyed pike, sometimes called pike perch or California salmon," in lines 11 and 12 of said bill.

(3.) Amend by striking out the word "wilfully," after the word "shall," in line 20 of said bill.

(4.) Amend by adding the words "for sale or for fertilizing purposes," after the word State on line 21 of said bill.

(4½.) Amend by inserting the word "willfully" after the word "shall" on line 49 of the bill.

(5.) Amend by adding the words "except as permitted by the preceding sections of this Act" after the word "intentionally" on line 50 of said bill.

(6.) Amend by striking out the whole of section 76 C, of said bill.

(7.) Amend by adding the word "gunpowder" after the word "dynamite" on line 85 of said bill.

(8.) Amend by striking out the words "on any line, poison, acid or any other substance" on lines 85 and 86, of said bill.

(9.) Amend by adding the words "gunpowder as other explosive substances" after the word "dynamite" in line 99 of said bill.

(10.) Amend by adding the words "or for the purposes of taking shad, herrings or mullets," at the end of sections 78 E, of the bill.

(11.) Amend by adding the words "except between the 1st day of April and the 31st day of May, both inclusive" after the words "at any time" in line 118 of the bill.
